State-level Guidelines for implementation of New India @75 Campaign in Colleges  
(Phase II)

Duration: October 12 – November 12, 2021

In order to commemorate 75 years of India's Independence, Assam State AIDS Control Society (ASACS) under the guidance of National AIDS Control Organization (NACO) is organizing New India @75 (2<sup>nd</sup> Phase) with campaigns on HIV, TB and Blood Donation awareness in different phases starting from October 12, 2021 by engaging adolescents and youth of select 25 colleges at state and district-level through various activities which would inculcate safe behavioural practices and reduce the menace of stigma & discrimination related to HIV and co morbidities.

All the select colleges/universities (enclosed) shall adhere to the following:

1. Each college will conduct/organize 3 (three) nos of competitions on three different themes - i) HIV ii) TB iii) Blood Donation simultaneously (October 12-20, 2021)
2. The college may conduct any one competition for each theme. The competitions include:
  - i) HIV
    - A) Poster Making Competition
    - B) One-minute video on HIV which needs to be posted in social media of ASACS
    - C) Quiz on HIV
  - ii) TB
    - A) Poster Making Competition
    - B) One-minute video on TB to be posted in social media of ASACS
  - iii) Blood Donation
    - A) Poster Making Competition
    - B) One-minute video on Blood Donation to be posted in social media of ASACS
3. Each college will ensure at least 50-70 no of participants/students for each Competition.
4. The competitions may be conducted in hybrid mode (online/offline) depending on the COVID situation. If the competitions are conducted in physical mode, the college authorities will ensure that the COVID protocol is maintained.
4. There will be prize money for the winners of the competitions (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>) for all three themes. All participants will receive e-certificates.

5. The respective college will engage 3 nos of Nodal Officers to conduct 3 nos of competition (HIV/TB/Blood Donation).
6. An honorarium will be provided to the Nodal Officers as token of appreciation for successfully conducting the competitions.
7. Every college will ensure their participation of minimum 100 students (per college) along with the nodal officers, faculty and the head of the institution during the the online launching of the programme on October 12, 2021 by National AIDS Control Organization (NACO), New Delhi. The link for the event will be shared with the colleges in the due course of time. All participants will receive e-certificates.
8. The respective college will organise/conduct competitions from October 12 to November 12, 2021.
9. For evaluation of the competitions, a committee will be formed under the Chairmanship of the Head of the Institution who will evaluate and select the winners.
10. After the completion of the competitions the college will felicitate the Nodal Officers.
11. The Nodal Officers after the competition of the competitions will prepare a detailed report and submit the same to Assam State AIDS Control Society (ASACS). As format will shared with colleges.
12. The fund for the competitions (Prize Money/Honorarium/Contingency) will released to the respective colleges in their official bank accounts.
13. The respective college will share the Bank details ( Bank/Branch/Account Name/Account Number/IFSC Code) to ASACS in official mail id [rrciecassam@gmail.com](mailto:rrciecassam@gmail.com) / [asacsaddp@gmail.com](mailto:asacsaddp@gmail.com)
14. Post evaluation of the campaign through Feedback form/Questionnaire will be done by ASACS with the help Nodal Officers of the respective colleges.
15. The respective colleges will submit the UCs/SoEs as per prescribed format of ASACS along with reports and photos.


