Report on Celebration of World Environment Day 2023

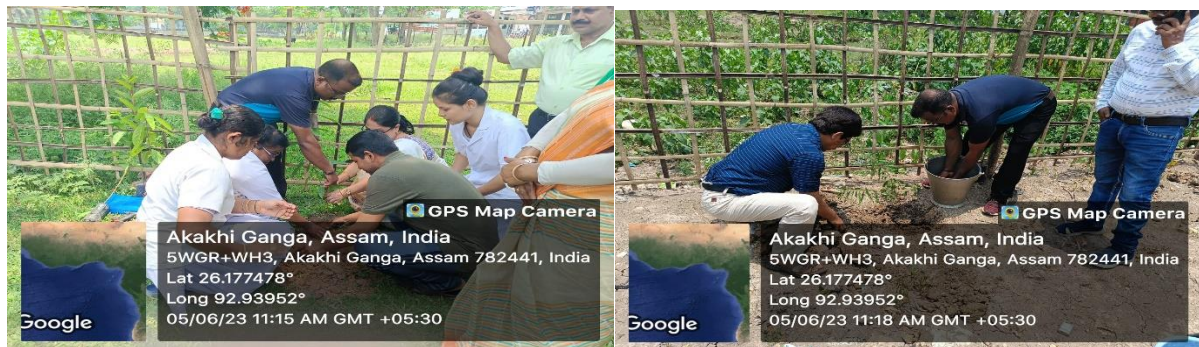
